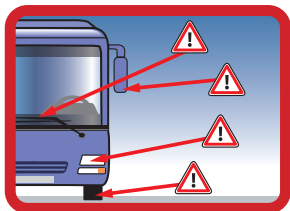




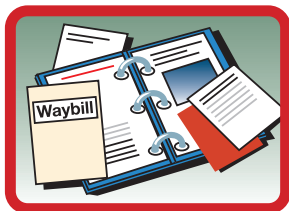
## The Coach Driver's Safety Card

Check the vehicle and transport documents



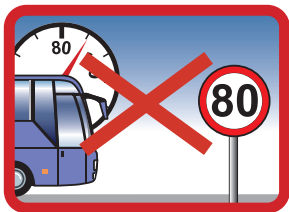
Adjust your seat



Fasten your seat-belt



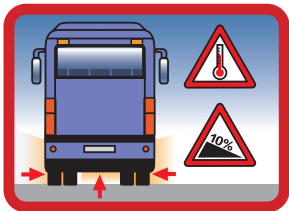
Respect speed limits



Remember the blind spot



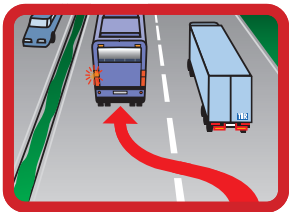
Stop if your engine or brakes overheat



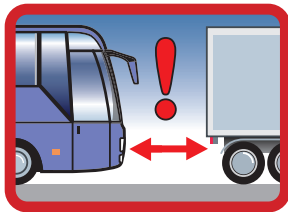
Don't drink and drive

Keep a safe distance



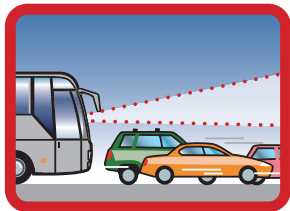
Adapt your driving to weather conditions



Park only where permitted



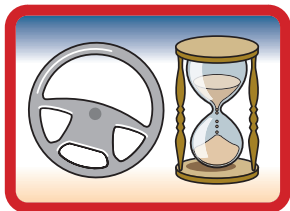
Anticipate upcoming traffic problems
